

## Steps to Success: Transition at Age 3

Eligible Disabilities:

### *Questions Parents Can Ask*

What does our child need to grow and develop?  
How do we want our child to play and learn?  
Where would our child be going to school if he or she did not have a developmental delay or disability?

### *More Questions Parents can Ask*

How will it be determined if my child is eligibility for special education or for other services?  
What Information is needed to determine eligibility?  
How will the information be provided?  
When will assessment take place?  
What testing may be done?  
Can a family member be present for testing?  
What placement options are available through the local school district?  
Who can we call if we have more questions?

Head Start, if available may also be a placement option for a child who is not referred for special education.

### *Still More Questions Parents Can Ask*

What transportation services will be available?  
Can my child visit the new school with me?  
Will the teacher understand times when my child needs special help?  
How do the teachers and families communicate?  
Are there activities for families?  
What supplies will my child need?
