Who Helps	A inter-disciplinary staff of doctors, nurses, social worker and community agencies
What to the do	Help identify goals for the future and then access state, regional and community resources to reach those goals.
Provides	A medical evaluation as well as care coordination for children, youth, and young adults with disabilities and serious chronic illness
Also provides	Information and support to families about health issues, special education, insurance, independent living
Ages served	Physician can refer patient between the ages 11 and 22 to the center for consultation (Wishard Primary Care Center)
