Minimum immunization requirements for students enrolled in Kindergarten

- 5 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis (DTaP), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTP), or pediatric diphtheria-tetanus vaccine (DT), or 4 doses are acceptable if the 4th dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday; (under 7 years of age).
- 4 doses of any combination of IPV or OPV by age 4-6, or 3 doses of all OPV or IPV are acceptable if the 3rd dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday.
- 2 doses of measles (rubeola) vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 1 dose of rubella (German measles) vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 1 dose of mumps vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 3 doses of hepatitis B vaccine for all Kindergarten and Grade 1 students, and
- 1 dose of Varicella (Chickenpox) on or after the first birthday or record of disease. Parental written report of a child's history of chickenpox is acceptable as proof of immunity (no vaccine needed.) A written statement from the parent/guardian indicating dates of disease and signed is all the documentation needed. Documentation by a physician is not necessary.
