Minimum immunization requirements for students enrolled in
Pre- Kindergarten

- 4 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis (DTaP), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTP), pediatric diphtheria-tetanus vaccine (DT), or any combination of the three are required.
- 3 doses of either oral Polio (OPV) or inactivated polio (IPV) vaccine.
- 1 dose of measles (rubeola) vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 1 dose of rubella (German measles) vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 1 dose of mumps vaccine on or after the 1st birthday.
- 1 dose of Varicella (Chickenpox) on or after the first birthday or record of disease. Parental written report of a child's history of chickenpox is acceptable as proof of immunity (no vaccine needed.) A written statement from the parent/guardian indicating dates of disease and signed is all the documentation needed. Documentation by a physician is not necessary.
